The intent of this letter is to express my appreciation for your fine representation in the matter of our insurance claim on the Ft. Worth Tower.

On March 29th a level F-2 tornado struck our property, Bank One Tower of Ft. Worth. The effect of this storm was severe damage to our property as well as significant portions of the downtown area of Ft. Worth. This disaster was significantly far reaching to require the closure of much of the Ft. Worth Central Business District and buildings within it. The effects to our own building were such that the entire glass curtain wall of our 37-story building was destroyed, significant interior damage was sustained displacing all of our tenants and it became apparent that reconstruction would take more than a year to complete.
